Monitoring the distribution of microelements and vitamins in the towns and districts of Sughd region

This week, the State Institution “Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development” specialists together with the public organization “Avesto” employees monitored the distribution of microelements and vitamins in the towns and districts of Sughd region (Khujand town, B. Gafurov and J. Rasulov districts).

A working meeting was held with Muhiddin Habibullo Khairullozoda, Head of the Regional Health Department.

During the meeting, the parties expressed their opinions on the issues of providing the target population (pregnant women and children aged 6 to 59 months) with micronutrients and vitamins, the activities of reproductive health centers and health centers of the towns and districts of Sughd region in this direction, as well as food fortification for protection of public health and prevention of nutrition-related diseases.

Afterwards, the working group met with officials and staff of reproductive health centers and child disease centers in Khujand town, B. Gafurov and J. Rasulov districts and checked the process of documenting and distributing micronutrients and vitamin supplements to the target population, including pregnant women and children aged 6 to 59 months.

Conversations were held with patients using micronutrients and vitamins.

The patients stated that their health improved after using health products (micronutrients and vitamin supplements). They also expressed their gratitude and endless appreciation to the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan and the State Institution “Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development” for

their continued support.



MONITORING THE PROGRESS OF FIELD WORKS IN SUGHD REGION

On May 21 this year, specialists of the State Institution "Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development" within the framework of the "Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project" familiarized themselves with seasonal works of farmers (project beneficiaries) in Sughd region.

It should be noted that potato harvesting has started in B. Gafurov district and the harvest is very high. At present, all crops are growing well in the field, inter-row cultivation, fertilization, irrigation and protective measures (pest control) continue.

Farmers are determined to harvest a good crop this year, as they did last year, to supply markets inside and outside the country and get good income by selling the agricultural products.

In the atmosphere of peace and stability, the honest work of

every farmer with good intentions to ensure food security of the country is a source of pride, honor and praise.

SEMINAR BY THE “SOIL DOCTOR” PROGRAM

With the support of the State Institution “Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development” together with the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations in the Republic of Tajikistan (FAO), theoretical and practical training seminars by the program “Soil Doctor” have been held since April 28 this year.

The purpose of such training seminars is to train soil specialists to test the composition of soil elements using modern technologies and to implement the necessary measures to restore microelements in the soil, thereby increasing the yield of agricultural crops.

The training seminar “Soil Doctor” within the framework of the “Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project” is planned to be periodically held throughout the country for soil specialists, and currently this event is being held in Vahdat town.

During the training workshop, reports on the above issues were presented by a series of presentations covering a wide range of topics important for soil testing and integrated soil protection.

The next seminar is held for two days (May 20 and 21), and in

the section of field soil testing, specialists in this field, according to the plan, determined various elements of soil and the actual state of its composition with the use of modern equipment.

This event is intended for specialists in soil science and agriculture to improve their knowledge and skills in the field of soil science and the use of modern technologies in practice.

At the end of the seminar, an interesting discussion on soil science was held, during which the participants received comprehensive answers to their questions.

It should be noted that this year as well, with the support of the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan, the State Institution "Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development" within the framework of the "Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project" provided a number of seed-growing, vulnerable and farming enterprises, production cooperatives and other farms with more than 8 types of high-quality certified climate-zoned seeds, such as wheat, potatoes,

cotton, onions, peas, corn, flax and beets.

The farmers (project beneficiaries) were able to organize sowing of these crops in a timely manner and ensure their good growth by following proper agronomic standards.

Currently, good growth of all crops is observed in the fields, inter-row cultivation, fertilizing, watering and protective measures (pest control) are ongoing. Some farmers have already started harvesting vegetables, legumes and fruits, preparing to supply them to the domestic market and for export.

ONION HARVESTING IN THE KATLON OBLAST BOKHTAR REGION

With the support of the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan, the State Institution "Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development" within the framework of the "Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project" annually provides quality certified seeds, both locally produced and from abroad, to vulnerable farms and seed growers in the country to increase crop yields, develop seed production and ensure food supply to the country.

This year, the State Institution "Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development" within the framework of the "Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project" provided quality onion seeds of Hazar, Seyhan and Albeni varieties from Turkey, which, according to the Republic of Tajikistan Ministry of Agriculture plan, were provided to 12809 vulnerable farms of the country.

The imported seeds are certified, zoned to the climatic conditions of Tajikistan and high-yielding.

Farmers of the country (project beneficiaries) effectively used autumn season favorable weather conditions and sowed onions in due time.

It should be noted that the institution provided 4,416 kg of quality onion seeds of Hazar and Seyhan varieties to 736 vulnerable farms in the towns and districts of Khatlon region under the "Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project".

Compliance with agrotechnical norms allowed the farmers in the region (project beneficiaries) to obtain high onion yields and start harvesting.

At present, onion harvesting in Panj, Jaihun, N. Khusrav, Shartuz, Kabadiyan and Dusti districts continues, and farmers provide the crop for the domestic market and leave some for export as well.

The farmers expressed their gratitude to the continuous support of the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan and the State Institution "Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development".
