This year, as part of the project, the institution provided the region vulnerable farms (beneficiaries) with 620 tons of high-quality potato seeds of the Evolution, Picasso and Arizona varieties. Favorable weather conditions and timely implementation of agrotechnical measures ensured good growth and increased yields.

During the biological yield assessment (testing), the sector specialists stated that this year harvest was very good, and serious steps are being taken to develop the seed sector.

Potato harvesting has now begun in the districts of Kuhistoni Mastchoh (Mountain Matchoh), Devashtich and Shahristan of the Sughd region, and farmers are striving to harvest a rich yield on time and without losses.

The State Institute "Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development" Project Management Unit (AED PMU) now invites sealed Proposals from eligible Proposers for the Development of an Agricultural Remote System Analyzing System "AMIS REMOTE", a comprehensive agricultural management information system designed to support multilevel plant production planning, monitoring, and reporting through its three interconnected subsystems: AMIS Remote Web for centralized data management and visualization, AMIS Remote Mobile for field data collection, and AMIS Remote Studio for advanced satellite image processing, analysis, and AI model generation, to be installed in the headquarters office (Dushanbe/Tajikistan) of the Client in 24 weeks.

The Bidder shall demonstrate that it has successfully completed at least two (2) contracts of similar scope and value to the proposed Information System (Countrywide implemented and integrated information system) within the last six (6) years, each with a value of at least one million one hundred (1 000 000.00) USD, that have been successfully completed.

POTATO HARVESTING IN GBAO

Along with other agricultural crops, potatoes are one of the main foods for the country population, and in recent years their cultivation area has increased due to demand.

To develop seed production, with the support of the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan, the State Institution "Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development" provided vulnerable farms (project beneficiaries) with 1,400 tons of high-quality certified seeds of the Arizona, Evolution and Picasso varieties during the potato planting season as part of the "Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project".

This year, farmers in GBAO, along with the country other towns and districts, are harvesting a rich potato yield within the established timeframe and following agricultural practices, having planted 70 tons of high-quality certified seeds of the Arizona variety, which is adapted to climate conditions and high-yielding.

Currently, the potato yield is high, and farmers are working hard to harvest it on time and without losses. They are also taking decisive steps to ensure food security and develop the seed sector in the region.

PLANNED COTTON HARVESTING IN KHATLON REGION IS GOING ON

CONSTRUCTION OF YEAR-ROUND MODERN GREENHOUSES IN THE COUNTRY

Today, the country has effectively functioning permanently working greenhouses, enabling the efficient use of every land plot and providing the country population with fresh vegetables year-round. However, due to the high demand for fresh vegetables all seasons, officials are striving to increase the number of modern year-round greenhouses.

For this purpose, the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan takes the necessary measures to increase the area of \(\subsection \) modern year-round greenhouses in all towns and districts of the country and implements them step by step according to the plan.

This year, with the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan support, the State Institution "Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development" is building two modern year-round greenhouses: one in GBAO Shugnan district and another one in Khatlon region Dangara district, as part of the "Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project".

Construction work is currently underway in both greenhouses, and engineers are striving to build and commission the facilities according to the international standards within the set timeframe by the new modern design.

The area for growing vegetables in the modern greenhouses is planned to cover 0.32 hectares of land, and the harvest will be available at markets year-round.
