The Republic of Tajikistan has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contracts for the Construction of Agrologistic Centers (ALC): Lot 1. Construction of ALC in Balkhi District; Lot 2. Construction of ALC in Khujand City.

2. The State Institute "Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development" Project Management Unit now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for the Construction of Agrologistics Centers (ALC): Lot 1. Construction of ALC in Balkhi District; Lot 2. Construction of ALC in Khujand City. The construction period of the facilities is 18 months (each). Defect Notification Period is 12 months. Construction works consist of excavation works, foundation, frame installation, installation of beams, construction of ladders, electrical works, water supply and sewerage, roofing, flooring, finishing works, etc. The margin of preference shall not apply.

3. Bidding will be conducted through international competitive procurement using Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the

**Renovation and Reconstruction Works at the Institute of Crop  
Production of the Tajik Academy of Agricultural Sciences**

The Government of the Republic of Tajikistan pays close

attention to the development of various sectors of the country, taking necessary measures to create favorable conditions for specialists in these fields.

With the support of the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan, the State Institution 'Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development,' within the framework of the 'Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project,' is carrying out the renovation and modernization of several scientific and educational buildings under the Ministry of Agriculture of the Republic of Tajikistan and the Tajik Academy of Agricultural Sciences, applying modern and contemporary architectural solutions.

As part of the first component of the project, high-quality painting of the external facade of the building of the Institute of Crop Production of the Tajik Academy of Agricultural Sciences was completed, covering an area of 1,325 square meters. Additionally, three entrances were repaired and renovated, covering an area of 13 square meters.

The building of the research institution, which has been known as the Institute of Crop Production since Soviet times, continues to operate effectively. This year, the external facade underwent a complete overhaul, with the surrounding fences and windows repaired and repainted.

Furthermore, the roof's drainage pipes, emergency staircases, and the doors of the main entrance were replaced.

Throughout the construction process, all details of the renovation were carefully considered to ensure the long-term durability of the building.

**The cotton harvest in Sughd Province is progressing steadily**

With the support of the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan, the State Institution 'Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development,' as part of the 'Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project,' provided seed-growing farms in various cities and districts of Sughd Province with seeds of three high-quality elite cotton

varieties—Lim, Laser, and Ramses—during the planting season.

Motivated by this continued support, farmers (the project's beneficiaries) have cultivated cotton across 840 hectares this year, with 160 hectares sown with the Lim variety, 240 hectares with the Laser variety, and 440 hectares with the Ramses variety.

These imported varieties are distinguished by their high yield potential and are well-suited to local climatic conditions and variations. This year, by adhering to advanced agricultural practices, farmers were able to substantially increase cotton productivity, achieving yields of 20 to 27 centners per hectare during the first harvest.

Currently, the cotton harvest is ongoing in the cities and districts of the province, and farmers are confident that, with favorable autumn weather conditions, the yield from the Lim, Laser, and Ramses varieties could reach up to 40-50 centners per hectare.

## **Renovation and Reconstruction Works in Agricultural Research Institutions**

With the support of the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan, the State Institution 'Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development' is carrying out repairs and reconstruction of several scientific and educational buildings under the Ministry of Agriculture of the Republic of Tajikistan and the Tajik Academy of Agricultural Sciences as part of the 'Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project.'

As part of the third component of the project, high-quality painting of the entire external façade of the building of the Institute of Soil Science and Agrochemistry of the Tajik Academy of Agricultural Sciences was carried out, covering an area of 1,979 square meters. In addition, the entrance to the building was repaired and renovated, covering an area of 44.71 square meters.

Moreover, the roof of the research institution, which had been

in a worn-out condition for many years, was completely renovated, covering an area of 1,164 square meters. All the work was completed with high quality.

The conference hall of the research institution, which was in need of major repairs, was renovated over an area of 97 square meters using modern design solutions. During the renovation, doors and windows were replaced, as well as flooring, ceiling, and new chandeliers and air conditioners were installed.

The contractors and workers involved in the construction work took into account all the subtleties of the construction process and, in accordance with the ecological and social standards of the World Bank, carried out high-quality repairs to ensure the building could serve for a long time.

The management of the Institute of Soil Science and Agrochemistry of the Tajik Academy of Agricultural Sciences expressed their gratitude to the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan for their ongoing support.

## **SEED DISTRIBUTION FOR AGRICULTURAL CROPS PROCEEDS EFFICIENTLY**

The development of agriculture is one of the priority areas of the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan, with officials consistently paying comprehensive attention to ensuring the country's food security.

With the support of the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan and the World Bank, specialists from the State Institution "Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development" are continuing the distribution of high-quality onion and wheat seeds across the country this year, just as they did last year, as part of the "Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector" project, in accordance with the established plan.

It should be noted that the distribution of high-quality seeds began on September 13, 2024, in cities and districts throughout the republic and is aimed at increasing the productivity of agricultural crops and ensuring the food security of the country.

The imported varieties of onion seeds include Seykhan – 1.2 tons, Albani – 3 tons, Khazar – 3 tons, and the wheat varieties include Grom – 200 tons, Alekseevich – 400 tons, and Temiryazevka 150 – 500 tons. These high-yield varieties are adapted to the climatic conditions of Tajikistan and are intended for distribution among more than 7,000 small, vulnerable farms across the republic.

The consulting services (“the Services”) for monitoring and evaluation to determine the eligibility of the selection of vulnerable farms before distribution of seeds and small farm equipment.

The State Institute "Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development" Project Management Unit now invites eligible consulting firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criteria are:

- a. Legal status recognized by the Republic of Tajikistan and allowing the firm to perform the above-mentioned tasks in accordance with national legislation;
- b. The firm shall have experience in conducting surveys, developing methodology and questionnaires for conducting surveys, as well as in conducting trainings and field work for at least 10 years, confirmed by constituent documents, copies of earlier implemented contracts, letters of recommendation/positive reviews of organizations.
- c. Availability of own field network in all regions of Tajikistan, confirmed by staffing or contracts with regional offices
- d. The local firm or NGO staff includes at least 5 specialists with experience in research and analytical work in the field of marketing as the head of a firm, department, project or leading researcher/analyst for at least 5 years.

The credibility of mentioned experience shall be presented in a list of the required similar project/contracts as required above, including description of services provided (including information on contract value, contracting entity/client, project location/country, duration, assignment budget, percentage carried out by consultant in case of association of firms or subcontracting and main activities) and accompanied by certificates/confirmation of orderly fulfilment of the contracts verified by other party from such contracts.

### **Quality seeds – guarantee of high yield**

With the support of the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan, the State Institution "Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development" under Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project annually imports high quality certified seeds from abroad. These measures are aimed

at increasing crop yields, ensuring food security and developing seed production. Seeds are provided to seed producing, farming and vulnerable households throughout the country.

It is important to notice that on September 15, 2024, 7200 tons of high-quality onion seeds (Seyhan varieties – 1200 tons, Albeni – 3 tons and Hazar – 3 tons) were imported from the Republic of Turkey. According to the plan, the seeds were distributed to 1,209 small vulnerable farms across the country.

All imported seeds are certified, high-yielding and adapted to the climatic conditions of Tajikistan, aimed at developing the agrarian sector and ensuring food security.
