

RENOVATION AND RECONSTRUCTION AT THE TAJIK AGRARIAN UNIVERSITY NAMED AFTER SH. SHOTEMUR

MONITORING THE PROGRESS OF FIELD WORK IN SUGHD REGION

Every year, specialists of the State Institution "Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development" within the framework of the "Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project" monitor the progress of field work throughout the country and all crops growth in the fields.

timely and safe harvesting of mature crops and re-sowing.
