Strengthening plant protection direction in the country

The State Institution "Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development" under the sub-component 3.3 of the "Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project", envisaged the aspect on strengthening the capacity of institutions for plant protection and locust control, measures on protection from pest are planned, including the organization of biological laboratories, as well as investments in material and technical base and capacity building of young staff of state institutions responsible for plant protection and locust control, including equipment, materials and staff training.

In this context, from November 18 – 27 this year, the mission of the international consultant Prof. Dr. Joseph Kisch – Head of the Department of Plant Protection Integration of the Hungarian Agrarian University and the Institute for the Study of Plant Life and Protection, member of the French Academy of Agriculture, is ongoing.

According to the program of the mission, the assessment of the existing biological laboratory, plant protection, pest control and capacity building of young employees of the Institution "Plant Protection and Chemicalization of Agriculture" was carried out, as well as several meetings were held with specialists and decision makers of the Ministry of Agriculture, Committee for Environmental Protection, Tajik Agrarian University, Tajik Academy of Agricultural Sciences, Institute of Horticulture and Viticulture, Agricultural Institute, public organizations for environmental protection, National Association of dehkan (farmer) farms and private sector.

At the same time, completed a working visit to the branches of the State Institution "Plant Protection and Chemicalization of Agriculture" in the Khatlon and Sughd regions, as well as to the biological laboratories of the village community Jamoat

“Panj” in Dusti district and village community Jamoat “Eshbek Sattorov” in Jaihun district, LLC “Markazi biomethod Kishovarz” in J. Rasulov district. Meetings were held with specialists and farmers to implement further activities using modern methods, and science-based recommendations were presented.

It should be noted that the project envisages the construction and equipping of a biological laboratory in state agricultural institutions.

Seed Potato Harvesting in the Foothill Areas of Sughd Region

This year, seed farms in Sughd Region (project beneficiaries), taking advantage of favorable weather conditions, timely conducted sowing operations, including the planting of potatoes, on an area of 83 hectares. As a result of proper adherence to agricultural techniques, crop yields have significantly increased, and farmers have begun harvesting.

It is worth noting that with the support of the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan, the State Institution "Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development" provided high-quality elite-certified seed potatoes of the "Evolution", "Picasso", and "Arizona" varieties to seed farms across the country as part of the "Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector" project for the sowing campaign.

Motivated by the continued attention from the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan, seed farms are committed to harvesting the crops on time and without losses.

Currently, average yields are between 750-850 centners per hectare, with some areas reaching up to 950 centners per hectare, marking a significant step forward in the development of seed farming.

Working Meeting on Agricultural Digitalization

On October 15, 2024, a working meeting was held at the State Institution “Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development” as part of Subcomponent 3.1 of the “Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector” project. The meeting focused on the potential for data analysis, planning, and real-time monitoring to ensure sustainable agricultural development.

The working group included representatives from the Ministry of Agriculture, the United Nations Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO), the Agency for Hydrometeorology, and the State Institution "Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development". The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the regular and timely collection of essential data on land use and agricultural production through digital technologies, and how this data can be transformed into actionable insights, including crisis preparedness and response.

Additionally, this subcomponent will support the production of real-time agrometeorological data, enabling the Ministry of Agriculture to improve its capacity to collect and analyze accurate weather information. In collaboration with the Agency for Hydrometeorology, the plan includes timely notifications and forecasts for farmers, aimed at reducing delays in accessing agrometeorological information.

The World Bank Mission's working group conducted an inspection of research activities in the Sughd and Khatlon regions

The technical working group, consisting of representatives of the World Bank and environmental and social specialists of the State Institution "Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development," visited several work sites in the Sughd and Khatlon regions.

During the visit, the group inspected the "Free Economic Zone" (ALC), the State Institution "Locust Control Expedition," and several seed-producing farms in Sughd and Khatlon, including OJSC named after A. Jumayev, OJSC "S. Urunkhodjaev," Dehkan Farm "Yakkatoot" in J. Rasulov District, the "Kulyab" Trading Cooperative in Vakhsh District, and Dehkan Farm "Khoji Zakir" in Vakhsh District.

Throughout the inspection, the group discussed the proper storage of pesticides, compliance with safety regulations, adherence to sanitary and hygiene standards, conditions for storing mineral fertilizers and seed reserves, as well as compliance with the project's environmental and social

requirements and labor conditions monitoring.

It is worth noting that a biological laboratory operates at the A. Jumayev seed farm, where beneficial insects—entomophages—are bred for biological pest control. The results of this activity are extended to other districts. World Bank specialists reviewed the laboratory's work and positively evaluated the project's contribution to its future development.

Additionally, meetings were held with representatives of vulnerable farms, allowing the group to become familiar with the current social and environmental conditions of these farms.

In conclusion, environmental and social specialists provided valuable recommendations to the project beneficiaries for further improving their operations.

Distribution of Agricultural Machinery and Equipment in GBAO

With the support of the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan, the State Institution “Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development,” has launched a new phase of agricultural machinery and equipment distribution in the Gorno-Badakhshan Autonomous Region (GBAO) within the framework of the Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project.

It is important to note that the distribution of modern agricultural machinery coincided with the working visit of the Founder of Peace and National Unity, Leader of the Nation, President of the Republic of Tajikistan, respected Emomali Rahmon to GBAO. This equipment was delivered to vulnerable farms in the region (the project beneficiaries).

It should be emphasized that, in order to further strengthen the material and technical base and facilitate the work of farmers, on June 4, 2024, with the support of the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan, the institution had already

provided 21 units of modern machinery—tractors and motor cultivators with equipment—to seed-producing and vulnerable farms in GBAO within the framework of the Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project.

Fortunately, in the new phase on October 13, 2024, additional 15 units of modern small tractors with trailers and equipment were distributed to the vulnerable farms of the region.

The project beneficiaries expressed deep gratitude for the continuous support from the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan. This important initiative significantly eases the work of farmers and greatly increases the yield of agricultural crops.
