Rapid Cotton Harvesting in Khatlon Region

This year, according to the plan, seeds of elite cotton varieties "Laser," "Lima," and "Ramzes", provided by the State Institution "Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development" as part of the Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project were planted on an area of 2366 hectares. The seeds were distributed among seed production farms and institutions.

Farmers in the region were able to significantly improve cotton crop growth by strictly following agro-technical recommendations and are striving for a high yield. Specialists in the course of approbation have found that the yield of cotton fields is very high, and with stable fall weather, an excellent harvest is expected.

Currently, harvesting is carried out in Shakhritus, D/F Kudrat Rais, D/F Shahzamonbabo, D/F Kubodiyon, C/C "Avesto-5", J. Balkhi, C/C "N.Begov", Vakhsh, C/C "Nufuzi Vakhsh", C/C "Aslam" and in Farhor district in commercial cooperatives "Shamshod-05", "Dusti-60", "Shahi Akhtamjon". The works are being carried out at a high pace, and in some of these farms the first harvest has already been gathered.

Farmers express their gratitude to the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan for continuous support, including provision of quality seeds with high yields. They are determined to complete the harvest on time and without losses.

Meeting of the Steering Committee of "Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project"

On September 3, 2024, in the hall of the National Library of the Republic of Tajikistan, a meeting of the Steering Committee of "Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project" was held.

The meeting was attended by the Deputy Prime Minister of the Republic of Tajikistan, who is the Chairman of the Steering Committee, as well as representatives of the Ministry of Agriculture of the Republic of Tajikistan, executive bodies of state authorities of Dushanbe city, Sogd and Khatlon regions. Monitoring of the growth of seed potatoes in seed farms of the Sughd region

Specialists of the State Institution "Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development" within the framework of Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project from July 16 to 20 this year reviewed the progress of field work and the current state of seed potato growth. They visited seed and dehkan farms in Shakhriston, Devashtich, Istaravshan and Isfara districts.

Last year after sowing quality seeds and following potato cultivation techniques farmers (beneficiaries) got high yield from potato fields and were satisfied with the result.

This year, taking advantage of favorable weather, they planted crops, including seed potatoes of elite varieties Picasso, Evolution and Arizona, in a timely and efficient manner and within the established deadlines. As a result, potato crop growth in each region is now quite high.

Specialists of the institution together with the heads of

dehkan and seed farms, production and farming cooperatives "Farkhod", "Abdurakhimbek", "Ravshan" of the Shakhriston region, "Mukhamadaliev Alijon", "Jobirjon", "Sadullobobo", "Subkhonzoda", "Ovchii Gonchi", "Khodzhakho", "Khotam Gurbonov", "Gazantarak" and "Markazi Potato" of Devashtichsky district, "Obodoni" of Istaravshan and farm "Chorkukh" of Isfara visited seed potato growing areas. Potatoes of the elite varieties Picasso, Evolution and Arizona received high praise from experts and farmers.

Currently, protective measures against pests and inter-row treatments are being carried out in potato fields: fertilizing, loosening and weeding in accordance with agricultural cultivation techniques. Farmers are satisfied with the good growth of their crops and are busy with field work.

The institution's specialists provided farmers with useful scientific recommendations to promptly and quickly increase the yield of seed potatoes.

It is worth noting that from July 18 to July 20, 2024 in the potato growing areas of the Sughd region a national seminar was held on the topic "Technology for growing potatoes in the mountainous and foothill regions of Tajikistan."

The seminar was attended by the Deputy Prime Minister of the Republic of Tajikistan, Mr. Ziyozoda Sulaimon Rizoi, the Minister of Agriculture of the Republic of Tajikistan, Mr. Hakimzoda Kurbon, the Chairman of the Sughd region, Mr. Rajabboy Ahmadzoda, representatives of relevant committees and departments of the Republic, heads of individual cities and districts, representatives of the Ministry of Agriculture, the Sughd and Khatlon regions, cities and districts subordinate to the republic, the head office, board, departments and branches of agriculture, as well as farmers.

As part of this event, specialists from all cities and regions

of the republic took part. Participants also got acquainted with the best practices of the beneficiaries of the Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project in the farms of the Maschoi Kuhi, Ayni, Shakhriston, Istaravshan and Devashtich regions.

Compliance with safety requirements in TAAS scientific institutions

This week, within the framework of the Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Scetor Project, based on the agreement between the State Institution "Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development" and the Public Organization "Peshsaf", specialists of the Institute of Soil Science and Agrochemistry of TAAS sealed and removed obsolete chemical materials and pesticides. These materials were transported by a specialized vehicle to a special landfill for obsolete chemicals in Vakhsh district, in accordance with safety requirements.

Freshly produced chemical materials are required for soil and plant testing in laboratories of scientific institutions. Specific and accurate test indicators are the basis for increasing crop yields and are important for both specialists and farmers.

Gradual growth of crop yields

As the Founder of Peace and National Unity, Leader of the Nation, President of the Republic of Tajikistan Emomali Rahmon noted at the meeting with farmers: "We have favorable natural conditions and necessary resources. If we use them wisely and efficiently, we will be able to provide the country's population with food and solve the issue of food security — one of our national goals".

Specialists of the State Institution "Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development" together with the project beneficiaries constantly monitor the current state of crops nationwide and constantly take measures for their cultivation and growth.

This year, farmers in Sughd and Khatlon regions participating in the project have effectively utilized every inch of their fertile land. In accordance with the plan, they sowed elite seeds of Lazer, Lima and Ramses varieties on an area of 3,123 hectares (Sughd region — 800 hectares, Khatlon region — 2,323 hectares). Currently there are 2 to 5 pods on each plant. Cotton fields are growing very well and agro-technical works are carried out gradually.

Farmers are determined to increase cotton yields by using quality seeds and strictly following agrotechnical methods of cultivation. Like last year, they are aiming for a high and quality harvest.

Monitoring of field works in Tajikabad and Lakhsh districts

The development of the agrarian sector is considered one of the priority directions of the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan, which constantly takes necessary measures to provide the population with food.

With the support of the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan, the State Institution "Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development" within the framework of the Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project has been providing seed and vulnerable farms with various seeds of elite group of crops for two years. Following agrotechnical rules, farmers (beneficiaries) were able to get the desired harvest last year due to sowing of quality seeds.

This year they also took advantage of the favorable weather and started sowing crops, particularly seed potatoes, in a timely manner.

On the second and third days of the working visit, the specialists of the institution visited agricultural lands, in

particular, seed potato fields of elite varieties Evolution and Arizona, on farms "Sari Nai" and "Firdavs" of Tajikabad district, as well as on farms "Mirshodi Arzangi", "Kand", "Sarchashma", "Buston" and "Gandumak" of Lakhsh district. As a result of this inspection, the specialists highly assessed the growth of crops. Currently, agro-technical works on the fields are carried out uninterruptedly and the yield of all crops is good.

Monitoring of crop growth in the RRS

On July 3, 2024, specialists of the State Institution "Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development" within the framework of the Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project assessed the progress of field work and the current state of crops of potatoes, onions, tomatoes and other crops on farms and seed farms of Faizabad and Nurobod district.

As in previous years, farmers who received elite seeds at the expense of the State Institution "Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development" within the framework of the Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project, used quality seeds and due to favorable weather completed planting of crops on time and in accordance with agrotechnical requirements. Currently, the harvesting of cereals (wheat) is close to completion. Treatment of inter-row and protective furrows against pests, feeding, fertilizing, loosening and weeding of other field crops are carried out in accordance with agrotechnical norms. Farmers are satisfied with good crop

growth and are actively engaged in field work.

Specialists of the institution visited seed farms of Tukhmparvari State Unitary Enterprise named after A. Nazirov, farm "Zamira" of Faizabad district, farm "Nuri Nurobod", farm "Hodjiabdulbako" of Nurobad district and studied cultivation and growth of agricultural crops, especially seed potatoes of different varieties and received high marks. Farmers were also provided with valuable scientific recommendations on increasing yields of all crops.
