SUPPORT FOR NATIONWIDE ACTIVITIES TO PROVIDE MICRONUTRIENTS AND VITAMIN SUPPLEMENTS IN PHC IN TAJIKISTAN

A roundtable discussion on “Support for nationwide activities to provide micronutrients and vitamin supplements in PHC in Tajikistan” was held at the SI “National Library of Tajikistan” as part of the “Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project”. Participants included Zohir Nabiev, Head of the Department for Maternal and Child Health Services and Family Planning at the Ministry of Health and Social Protection of the Republic of Tajikistan, Khayriniso Yusufi, Goodwill Ambassador for Women's Cancer, Boymurod Kurbonzoda, Deputy Director of the “Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development” State Institution, heads of reproductive health centers, and representatives from medical facilities focused on maternal and child health.

Opening the roundtable, Zohir Nabiev, Head of the Department for Maternal and Child Health Services and Family Planning at

the Ministry of Health and Social Protection of the Republic of Tajikistan, noted that improving nutrition is crucial for improving public health.

It was noted that failure to comply with nutritional rules and requirements leads to increased maternal and child mortality. Hundreds of thousands of people die every year worldwide as a result of malnutrition.

It should be noted that the World Bank-financed “Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project” is being implemented within the framework of the “Support for nationwide activities to provide micronutrients and vitamin supplements in PHC in Tajikistan” program, which is based on food support for development of the “Population Health Strategy of the Republic of Tajikistan until 2030,” including Section 3 “Food Security and Access to Quality Nutrition.”

As part of the “Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project”, micronutrients for pregnant women and vitamin supplements for children aged 6 to 59 months were procured and distributed based on clinical recommendations.

This event was planned to increase the knowledge of primary health care specialists and engage the media.

In 2019, the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan adopted the Law of the Republic of Tajikistan “On Providing the Population with Fortified Food Products” to protect public health and prevent nutrition-related diseases by food fortification. As part of this law implementation, the “Program for Prevention of Micronutrient Deficiency and Related Diseases among the Population of the Republic of Tajikistan for 2022-2027” was approved by Government Resolution No. 415 dated September 30, 2021.

Following the roundtable discussion, several participants expressed their views on the implementation of the “Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project”

PROGRESS OF REPAIR WORK AT THE VAKHSH STATE VARIETY TESTING STATION

Currently, with the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan support, the State Institution “Agriculture Entrepreneurship

Development” gradually renovates and restores a number of scientific and educational buildings, laboratories of the Ministry of Agriculture, the Academy of Agricultural Sciences of Tajikistan, and other essential facilities, using modern design and commissioning them, as part of the “Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project”.

All these construction, restoration, landscaping and site improvement works are the result of national independence, peace and unity; the government constantly takes the necessary measures to develop the country various sectors.

Our next facility is the Vakhsh State Variety Testing Station. Due to its existence since Soviet times, this facility was in need of major renovation.

This year, as part of the project, the State Institution “Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development” repaired and renovated the building roof, walls, interior finishing, floors and ceilings replacing windows and doors with high-quality ones. The building entrance, small electrical appliances and chandeliers were also completely replaced; a storage facility for seeds of various agricultural crops was built next to the building.

Currently, interior renovation and restoration work is fully completed, and the exterior finishing is nearing completion.

All nuances were considered during the renovation, and the building repair with modern design will be completed shortly.

The Vakhsh State Variety Testing Station management and staff are satisfied with the ongoing Government of the Republic of Tajikistan and the State Institution “Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development” support and express their gratitude for this building high-quality renovation.

**ASSESSMENT AND FEASIBILITY STUDY PHASE FOR AN AGROLOGISTIC
CENTER CONSTRUCTION IN KHOROG TOWN, GBAO**

The Government of the Republic of Tajikistan annually pays great attention to the sustainable development of the country various sectors and continuously takes the necessary measures to implement their plans.

The State Institution “Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development” within the “Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project” is conducting an assessment and feasibility study in collaboration with Sofreco (France) and by involving the international consultants for an agrologistic center construction in Khorog town, GBAO.

It is worth noting that, with the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan support, the State Institution “Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development” will build and commission five agrologistic centers in the country (Dushanbe, Sughd, Khatlon and GBAO regions) according to the international standards.

PROGRESS OF REPAIR AND RESTORATION WORKS AT THE STATE INSTITUTION “PLANT PROTECTION AND AGRICULTURAL CHEMICALIZATION”, B. GAFUROV DISTRICT, SUGHD REGION

The State Institution “Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development” annually takes the necessary measures to implement the “Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project” and constantly works to develop the agricultural sector.

With the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan support, the State Institution “Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development” has begun a major renovation of the State Institution “Plant Protection and Agriculture Chemicalization” building in the Sughd region B. Gafurov district as part of the “Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project”.

The building of the State Institution “Plant Protection and Agriculture Chemicalization” has been in operation since Soviet times (since 1985) and contributes to the agricultural crops’ protection in the region.

As this building has been in need of major repairs for many years, the State Institution "Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development" began renovation work in September this year. Within the project, the building will be repainted, the walls leveled, the interior, the floors and ceilings refinished, the doors and windows will be replaced with high-quality ones.

The building entrance, small electrical appliances and chandeliers will be completely replaced and renovated as well with quality and modern design.

Repair and restoration work is currently underway inside, outside and on the roof. Every detail is being considered during the renovation to ensure the long-term operation of the building and high-quality completion within the specified timeframe.

During the renovation, the Institution engineers, social and environmental specialists provided the workers involved in the work with detailed information on the environmental management plan, ecology impact assessment results, compliance with sanitary and hygienic standards, safety precautions, the requirements and standards of the Republic of Tajikistan current legislation and the World Bank, the grievance redress mechanism and compliance with other applicable laws.

POTATO HARVESTING IN THE SUGHD REGION DISTRICTS

Every year, as part of the “Strengthening Resilience of the Agriculture Sector Project”, the State Institution “Agriculture Entrepreneurship Development” supplies high-quality, certified, high-yielding and climate-adapted seeds of various agricultural crops, both local and produced abroad, to seed producers and vulnerable farms (project beneficiaries) of the country to develop the seed sector.

Farmers in the country effectively use these high-quality seeds and achieve high yields every season.

This year, as part of the project, the institution provided the region vulnerable farms (beneficiaries) with 620 tons of high-quality potato seeds of the Evolution, Picasso and Arizona varieties. Favorable weather conditions and timely implementation of agrotechnical measures ensured good growth and increased yields.

During the biological yield assessment (testing), the sector specialists stated that this year harvest was very good, and

serious steps are being taken to develop the seed sector.

Potato harvesting has now begun in the districts of Kuhistoni Mastchoh (Mountain Matchoh), Devashtich and Shahrستان of the Sughd region, and farmers are striving to harvest a rich yield on time and without losses.
